The City of Richardson has developed the following plan based on the guidelines requested by the NTMWD:

Last digit of address	Allowed landscape watering days
0,2,4,6,8 (Even)	Saturdays*
1,3,5,7,9 (Odd)	Sundays*

\*Use of automated sprinklers is not allowed from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
